- As members arrived, they were signed in and given a red, green, and blue card to be used for voting, for obtaining a ballot, and for speaking at the meeting. A meeting agenda, Spring 2019 membership meeting minutes and a Treasurer's Profit & Loss (January December, 2019, Balance sheet, Proposed 2020 Budget, and a bar graph showing BLPOA open invoices and it's impact on our budget. ROLL CALL: Joanne Parker

• The meeting commenced at 10:15 AM. Attendance exceeded the number needed for a quorum without reading attendees names. There were 81 households represented.

REVIEW OF THE MINUTES OF THE SPRING 2019 MEMBERSHIP MEETING;

- All approved. Minutes accepted.

OPENING STATEMENTS: Dana Margolis

- Welcome. Thank you for coming. Welcome to new members.
- Thank you to current board for all their time devoted to the lake community.

HAPPENINGS AROUND THE LAKE:

- South Dorr Beach Project is now finished. We improved the pathway to the beach for erosion control.
- Paving projects completed: Belleau Blvd. at Association Park and Belleau Blvd. at Vachon Beach
- Storage shed has been ordered for the Milfoil Team to store equipment.

PROPOSED BLPOA BYLAWS UPDATE: Dana Margolis

- New bylaws did not pass by the 2/3 majority vote required by the state of NH statutes.
- The voting results were:
 - 230 property owners voted, out of 420 properties
 - ❖ We had 197 **YES** votes
 - We had 33 NO votes
 - ❖ Nearly 50% of property owners did not vote

Many reasons for updating bylaws:

- ❖ Biggest concern is how our outdated bylaws prevent us from being able to fairly and appropriately act on collecting past membership fees.
- 57 property owners have past due accounts
- Committed to making these bylaws work for us. We will work to get the bylaws out for another vote.

OTHER NOTES FROM THE PRESIDENT; Dana Margolis

- If you are a property owner and you rent your property, inform all renters that the Town of Wakefield has ordinances stating no fireworks are allowed and there's a leash law for dogs.
- Please no glass bottles on our beaches
- The speed limit on all BLPOA roads is 15mph
- There are many lake hazards. Please follow all lake safety laws
- OHV/ATV and Dirt Bikes must follow all of the state of NH rules. Always be considerate of others.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS

- Upon showing their blue card passed out at check-in, members received a ballot and time was allowed for voting. (Sample ballot attached)
- Votes were then counted and tallied by Wendy Davis and Jane Daniell

DAM ASSOCIATION: John Brown

- Lake draw down begins on October 1, 2019
- Every 4 years, the lake is lowered early due to maintenance work on the dam
- Need 2-3 people to volunteer to be directors on dam board. Two meetings per year
- Please contact John Brown if you're interested
- Directors are appointed internally; no election

Member comments:

- Season was short this summer. Lake lowering too early.
- There should be a description of the responsibilities of a dam director.
- Please let members know in May when the lake draw down will occur in the fall.

TREASURER REPORT: Mary Vinagro

- Referred to and explained the handout of financials passed out at check-in
- Moved \$145,000. to a money market reserve account. Hoping to add to this fund next year
- Board voted to not raise dues. Set price: \$350. for a developed house lot, \$180. for an undeveloped lot.
- Budget has been adjusted to make our input of money match our output if everyone pays their dues
- 57 accounts (out of 426 total) have not paid, \$73,000.00 in outstanding dues
- Stressed importance of passing new bylaws so we can take action on delinquent dues
- Comments from Members:
 - Golf tournament: thought it was a profit for BLPOA?

Dana: Golf tournament goes through us, we get it back

 Do we have a time frame for when roads get paved? Want No. Dorr paved and Beverly Hills paved

Dana: Vachon Hill next. Trying to identify and pave problem areas first

- Does not want paving roads to be the reason for increase of dues
- We need to take people to court and put a lien on their property.
- Some people opposed to paying more for a lot (\$180.) because there will no longer be special deals like in the past. Cost is equal and fair for everyone.
- Feeling of frustration about people not paying their fair share in dues.
- We should amend just the section about collecting dues in the bylaws rather than starting with all new bylaws. Not everything needed to be changed.
- Everyone agreed we need to go back and get these people to pay

Dana: We are meeting with the lawyer later this month to look into legal proceedings to collect from overdue accounts. We want to get this started. Members asked to be sent an email after the lawyer meeting so they know where this issue stands.

Motion to accept Treasurer's Budget Report by Craig Donais; Seconded by Allan Trombley 80 approved, 1 opposed. Budget passed

- Very successful lake treatment in August
- Planning to work with the lake safety officer to discuss next year's operations
